Basic Requirements

The main requirement for successfully fostering or adopting a child in Alabama is a willingness and commitment to be a parent, as well as the ability to love and rear a child who needs **you**.

To adopt: Must be over 19 years of age; married (for at least 3 years) or single; if married, one must be a US citizen; if single must be a US citizen

To Foster: Must be over 19 years of age; married for at least one year or single

For Both: must meet minimum standards that include adequate housing and personal space for the child; must be healthy enough to meet the child's needs; must undergo a background check, including criminal history; must have sufficient income to meet your own expenses; and must undergo a preparation training.
