

Are you interested in affordable home ownership?

If you're hard-working, with a good record of paying your rent and utilities on time, you may qualify for affordable home ownership via the Chattahoochee Fuller Center Project. The monthly mortgage and utilities payments for a new, energy-efficient home may actually be less than what you're paying to live in a rental house!

We're now accepting applications for home ownership via "sweat equity" community service and zero-interest loans for families in West Point, Ga., and Lanett and Valley, Alabama.

This is not a giveaway program! Only qualified families who have a good record of rent and utility payments and who are willing to commit to 350 hours of community service are eligible.

We are building at least six homes this year – two in Lanett, two in Valley and two in West Point – and that's just the beginning. We're here for the long-term and will continue to build houses in all three communities in coming years. Our cost of a home will be between \$55,000 and \$60,000 because most labor and some materials are contributed.
